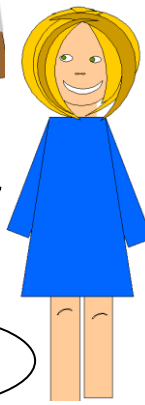
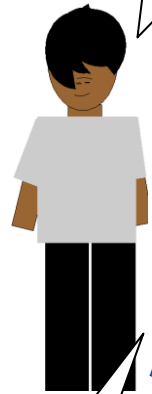
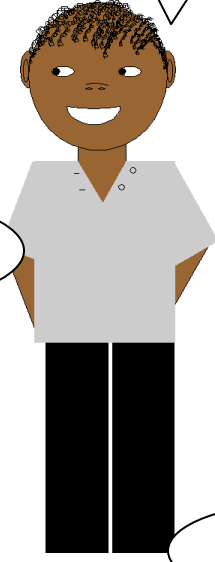
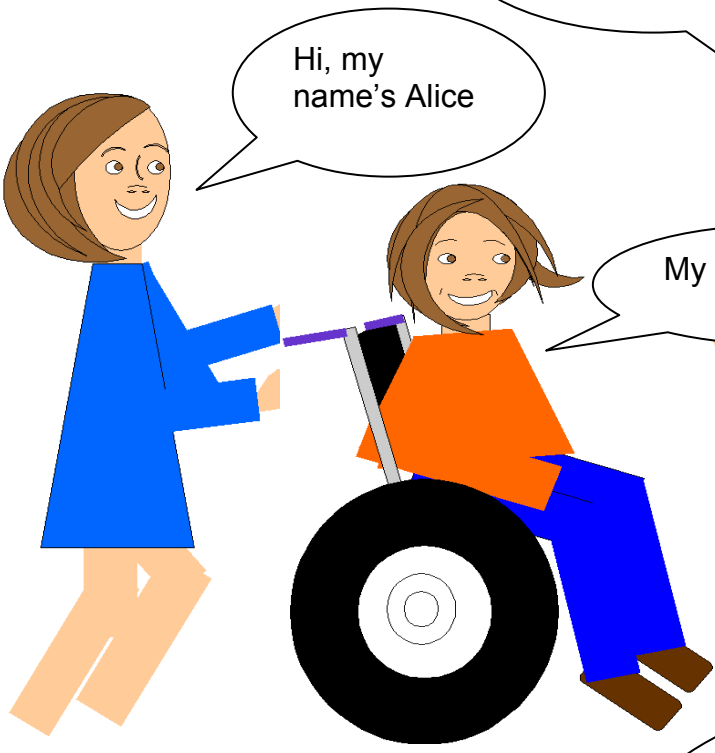




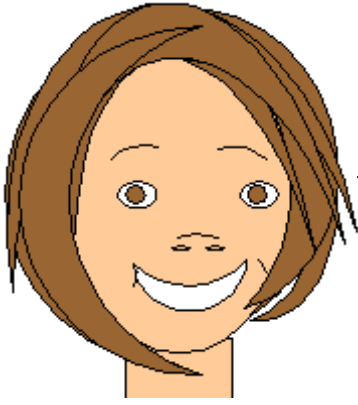
My name's Abi. Want to play in our game?
