## Safeguarding:

Safeguarding is essential in all schools, and their our several staff in school who focus on this.

Alex Hill and Clarissa Davy-Hoffman are the Safeguarding Officers at school.

If a worry is logged for a child, they will explore this, speak with the child and parents; to support in finding solutions and sometimes this happens through external agencies.

Sometimes, parents may receive calls due to an injury or being absent from school. For instances, like this please make sure to speak with the class teacher or call the school office, to prevent phone calls.

## Pastoral Support:

There are different forms of emotional support accessible for children in school.



We have ELSA; the term is emotional literacy support assistant. Mrs Stark runs sessions with children one-to-one or small groups helping them understand their emotions, when face with challenges and life experiences.

School also have Place2Be, an external counselling service in the form of art, play and talk therapy. They provide, one-to-one sessions, drop-in sessions; called Place2Talk and parenting support with a family practitioner called PIPT (Personalised Individual Parent Training).
