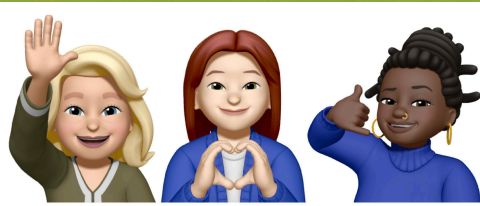
Safeguarding Officers
